Afternoon learning Science, Art, DT, Topic, Music/RE	Science investigation Part 2 What affects the brightness of a lamp in a circuit? This week we are investigating <i>how increasing the number of <u>cells</u> in a circuit</i> (battery) affects the brightness of each lamp. Use the worksheet here to investigate your ideas. Included is a link to try out your ideas and create your own using a virtual laboratory; especially if you don't have any bulbs or wires to use. Click here for the website. Complete the sheet and draw your circuit diagrams using the electrical symbols you have learnt in school. What is your conclusion? Now compare your investigation from last week and write an overall conclusion for both parts. What have you found out? Was your prediction correct? Were you surprised at what you found out?	Explain your reasoning for why your circuit works and why bulbs can be brighter (or dimmer). Use scientific language in your explanation.
