English and SPAG	You are learning about William Morris this week. He was associated with the Arts and Crafts movement, a group of artists and writers who used nature as a source of inspiration. Use your writing time this week to follow the suggestions in the afternoon topic plan to write a poem or story based on nature. Spread the work out, improving it each time you revisit your ideas. Write a poem: Think about nature, plants and flowers. Go outside and study how plants twine and twist upwards, stretching for the light and sunshine. Create a word bank to describe what you see, hear, feel and smell. Please don't taste! Use the words to help you write a poem. Write a story: Look at <i>The Strawberry Thief</i> design <a href="#">here</a> . Morris was inspired to create this when he saw thrushes stealing fruit from his garden in Oxfordshire. There is a close-up of the design <a href="#">here</a> as well. Look at the design carefully – what plants and animals can you see? Write a story in which strawberries or other fruit are mysteriously disappearing from a garden – who is the culprit, why are they taking it? Immerse it in the natural world, perhaps including other creatures such as frogs and toads, caterpillars and hedgehogs! Have you thought about writing it from the viewpoint of a character such as William Morris, a gardener, a bird, an animal or insect, or even yourself?
