Dear Parents,

After School Clubs

We are absolutely delighted that so many children attend our clubs and they are a real asset to the school. They are an invaluable opportunity for children to participate in a range of sports, craft and performing arts activities, as well as providing safe childcare for working parents. A lot of time and care is put into making sure there is something for all children.

When booking clubs:

- Please choose the clubs with your children as we cannot swap clubs once booked.
- Please note that due to popular demand, only 1 art session can be booked per child.
- Please note the finishing times for clubs as continued and repeated lateness will incur additional charges in line with CHILL club costs.

Ad-hoc clubs

It is possible to book Lego Plus! and Chill on an ad-hoc basis (£4 per session and £6 for the extended Chill). Please let the school office know in advance (preferably by midday on the day required). You pop into the office, call or email (please wait for a confirmation email in return to know that we have seen your message). Costs will be added to your ParentPay account the following week.

Chill Club – Now trialling an extended option until 6pm.

Due to popular request we are going to trial an extended Chill option until 6pm. It is still possible to book a 1 hour session from 4.30pm until 5.30pm (£4) and we are now offering an extended session from 4.30pm until 6pm (£6). If you have booked a 1 hour session you can add the 30 minute top up for £2 if you let us know in advance. This will automatically be charged to parents picking up late from the 1 hour session.

Behaviour

Children are expected to maintain the same standards for behaviour as expected in class:

- Children show the same respect for club leaders and coaches, the same as they would for any other member of school staff.
- Children follow the Diamond Rules, exactly as they would during the school day.
- Children behave well and contribute to the enjoyment of all club members.

Good work and positive choices will be rewarded with verbal praise, House Points or Reach-up/Reach-out stickers. Consequences for not following our Diamond Rules may include time out during the session or a conversation with parents and carers. Poor behaviour is recorded and their

teacher informed. If a child persistently fails to follow the Diamond Rules at clubs they will no longer be allowed to attend the club for the rest of the term and their teacher informed.

I would really appreciate your support in ensuring that all clubs are a positive experience for all children and coaches.

Safeguarding

- Please let the school office know in advance if your child is not attending a club that they are signed up for.
- Let the school office know if somebody else is collecting your child from an after school club.

Please be reminded that when collecting your child you must go to the correct classroom and sign for them.
