Pupil Premium Impact 2017 2018

The impact of the pupil premium grant is measurable in academic attainment as well as individual achievements. It is important to note the individual achievements as well as the academic as this holistic approach to the child has a direct impact on success later in life. During the academic year, the pupil premium children worked with a pupil premium champion on several smaller targets as well as the school tracking their academic progress. The Pupil Premium Champion is led by the children identifying their targets.

Some of these 'hard to measure' targets this year have included: being able to speak publicly in front of the class, being able to have a successful playtime and being able to organise themselves. Many of the children also attended ELSA sessions and improved their emotional understanding of themselves as well as others. Children also engaged in outdoor experiences in small groups to give them more opportunities to learn in a different environment and build new skills which otherwise had not been available. Pupil premium was also used for some children to support behaviour as well as art therapy.

Academic outcomes for Pupil premium children

All made expected or better progress in maths with half exceeding. All but 1 made expected progress in reading with a third exceeding. All but 3 made expected progress in writing with a quarter exceeding.

2 pupils left mid-year.

KS2 results – 1 PP child - ARE in maths and writing but missed ARE reading by 1 mark – remarked and was denied the appeal.

Other outcomes for Pupil Premium Children

100% of children achieved their personal target.

Year 2 "I feel good about my reading"

Year 2 "I am now a bit clearer about following the rules in school"

Year 5 "I am feeling more confident with my times tables and it is helping me in maths"

Year 6 "I feel quite good about tackling tricky reading comprehension and having more practice has helped"

Year 3 "I am feeling more confident with me spelling and I got 11 right this time!"

Year 6 "I stood up and started my speech to the class. I have never done that before!"

Other opportunities offered to Pupil Premium Children

- o All pupil premium children took part in a weekly club
- All pupil premium children were offered a place at holiday activity club 3/4 made use of the offer.
- o All pupil premium children attended residential trips and non-residential trips
- o All pupil premium children took part in the full scope of school life
- Half of the pupil premium children had the opportunity to learn a musical instrument (year group dependent)
