

SHADOW ACTIVITIES

- 1. Put some paper down under a tree or flower and draw around the shadow
- 2. Draw around someone else's shadow... put some paper down and draw around the shadow this can be the whole body or just a face outline you can do this with chalk too on tarmac or paving slabs
 - or.. see what natural materials you can find to make the shadow outline. Twigs, rope, bricks, pebbles... anything will do
 - → How does a shadow change depending on where you are standing?
- 3. Put 3D objects down and see what shapes their shadows show
- 4. Cut out shapes with paper and see how big you can make something (with its shadow) a bit like the big bad mouse in the Gruffalo's child
- 5. Can you catch someone else shadow?
- 6. Can you make any animal shadows with your hands?
